Our Aims

Our aim is to

- 1. Run month long camps at natural disaster affected areas, where our skilled volunteers will work side by side with farmers and community members on infrastructure projects.
 - 2. Send a clear and concise communication to disaster affected communities that they are not alone and PHP will provide assistance within its capabilities and framework.

PHP Snapshot

Selection

The PHP Board will select small communities that have been severely affected by drought, flood or fire.

Scope

We will travel to the selected area/s and work with farmers and community leaders to identify projects that PHP can provide.

Co-ordinate

- Logistics
- Timeframe
- Budget
- Assemble a team of skilled volunteers (maximum 20 per day) for three weeks
- Source materials
- Organise catering and accommodation
- · Complete risk assessments and implement a safety management plan

Begin

- Break into teams of between 4 and 6 volunteers
- Elect team leaders
- Work side by side with farmers and locals to complete projects

Providing volunteers with a brief insight into the lives of farmers and the rural communities they are helping usually brings with it a refresher course on old fashioned values and a 'check' on our moral compasses while ensuring we maintain our mission, vision and values.

About Us

In May 2017 we began our volunteer journey with five days work on a farm at Binnaway near Coonabarabran NSW.

The farm had been let go after the owner had suicided 12 months prior.

This proved to be a life changing event for us.

On our return home we decided to wind up our jobs and lives in Old Bar NSW and work fulltime as volunteer assessors for Rural Aid Australia.

2018 saw us assessing farms and coordinating volunteers at six locations from Ballendella VIC to Barcaldine QLD.

Due to the ongoing drought and Rural Aid's volunteer popularity in 2019, the programme grew. We went on to coordinate work at seven locations from Kyabram VIC in the south to Wondai QLD in the north. This involved 314 volunteers for the year, working on 35 farms and 17 rural community projects.

In 2020 Covid stalled the program while we were working on our last project in Gayndah QLD. While isolating at the Gayndah Showgrounds for 4 months, we decided to begin our next chapter by starting our own charity – and **People Helping People Australia Ltd was born!**

Volunteer Recruitment & Registration

As a charity, volunteers are the backbone of our organisation.

This is especially the case for our farm/community program as without volunteers, the program itself couldn't exist.

We value and encourage people of all ages and backgrounds to participate and attend our events.

Volunteers can register their interest to participate in the program via phone. They will then be sent a registration form.

It is policy that volunteers submit a current police check prior to the event with their registration form completed, and that they have agreed to the Code of Conduct.

Work Health & Safety

There is an obligation to the farmers assisted, but also to the volunteers who help in achieving the organisational goals, by having strict WH&S procedures.

We have developed a Work, Health and Safey Management System and are committed to the continual improvement of this system.

WH&S procedures and policies must be adhered to for all events.

We have a safety management plan.

Living on the road enables us to base ourselves in the affected areas and work directly with farmers and community groups.

We take tradies with specific skill sets to rural areas most in need where tradespeople are not available, or where communities cannot afford to call them in.
